

## Registration Information

### **Resident Discount ("Res-Disc.") vs. "Cost"**

Your resident address must fall within one of three Tracy Zip Codes (95376, 95377, or 95304) to receive our resident discount. In addition, your address must be within Tracy city limits. If your address has five digits or more, then your home may be outside the Tracy city limits. It is possible to live in one of the three Tracy zip codes and still not live within Tracy city limits. All non-residents pay the "cost" of a program.

### **Program Withdrawal/Transfer/Refund**

If you are not happy with the quality of any of our programs, please contact us right away. We want to resolve your concern so you can continue, or in some instances, receive a refund. You must complete a "Request for Class/Activity Withdrawal Form" and submit to the Program Coordinator. Withdrawals are subject to a \$5 transaction fee. Refunds are subject to an additional \$5 transaction fee. If you leave a credit on your account you will not be charged the additional transaction fee. No transaction fee for classes that have been canceled.

No refunds for non-attendance due to schedule conflicts or illness, no refunds for materials fees, and no refunds for classes that have completed. Allow 5 business days to process a refund.

**DO NOT ATTEND A CLASS UNTIL REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT HAVE BEEN COMPLETED. INSTRUCTORS CANNOT ACCEPT PAYMENTS.**

**Lifeguarding Certification (15+ years)**

Becoming a lifeguard is a rewarding job, but requires hard work and the desire to help save lives. This course includes e-learning, classroom learning, and pool time. Upon successful completion of the online course, written exams, and water skills, this course certifies participants in the American Red Cross Lifeguarding, First Aid, and CPR/AED (valid for two years). Come prepared to swim each class session. Candidates are welcome to apply for lifeguard positions with the City of Tracy after completion of the course.

**Note:** Attendance at all class days and times is required, along with passing scores on the online and written tests, and water skills in order to be certified as a Lifeguard.

**NEW! Lifeguard Recertification (15+ years)**

This is a recertification course for those already certified American Red Cross Lifeguards. This course includes e-learning, classroom learning, and pool time. Upon successful completion of the online course, written exams, and in person skills, this course certifies participants in the American Red Cross Lifeguarding, First Aid, and CPR/AED (Valid for two years.) Come prepared to swim. Note: Participants must bring proof of valid certification to the first day of class.

**NEW! Lifeguarding Instructor Certification Class (17+ years)**

This course trains instructor candidates to teach the basic-level American Red Cross Lifeguarding courses. Participants must have a current American Red Cross Lifeguarding/First Aid/ CPR/AED certificate and be at least 17 years old or older. To successfully become a certified LGI, participants must pass the prerequisite skills on the first day, successfully complete the Online Introduction to the LGI Course and pass all skill and teaching assessments. Attendance is required at all classes, in addition to assigned homework.






