The City of Tracy Planning Commission will conduct a Public Hearing on **Wednesday, July 23, 2025, at 7:00 p.m.**, or as soon after as possible, in the City of Tracy Transit Station, Room 103/104, 50 E. 6th Street, Tracy, to consider and take action on:

Application: Tracy Hills Phase 1C - Specific Plan Amendment (SPA22-0001) and Vesting Tentative Subdivision Map (TSM22-0001) – (1) Recommending the City Council approve an amendment to the Tracy Hills Specific Plan modifying development standards and adding Appendix F for Tracy Hills 1C design standards; (2) Recommending the City Council approve a Vesting Tentative Subdivision Map for the Tracy Hills Phase 1C project (APN: 251-040-08 and 251-040-19) to create 289 single family lots with associated home owner's association parcels and public space areas; and (3) Recommending the City Council determine that the Tracy Hills Phase 1C project is consistent with the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) that was certified by the City Council on April 5, 2016 for the Tracy Hills Specific Plan and therefore, in accordance with the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and CEQA Guidelines Sections 15162 and 15168(c)(2), no further environmental review is necessary.
