The City of Tracy Community and Economic Development Director will conduct a Public Hearing on **Wednesday, August 27, 2025, at 2:00 p.m.**, or as soon after as possible, in Conference Room 203, located on the 2nd floor of City Hall, 333 Civic Center Plaza, Tracy, to consider and take action on:

Application D25-0005: Ducky's Car Wash at Chevron – Public hearing to consider (1) approving a Development Review Permit, Application Number D25-0005, for the installation of two vacuum stalls, the construction of a 189 square foot equipment room, and related site improvements on a 0.92-acre site located at 1960 W. 11th Street, Assessor's Parcel Number 234-020-01; and (2) determining that this project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15311, pertaining to the construction of minor structures accessory to existing commercial facilities.

The Applicant is Ducky's USA LLC, and the Property Owner is Chevron USA Inc.
