Good Evening Mayor, Mayor Pro Tem, City Council Members, City Staff and Citizens of Tracy in attendance tonight.

As you know I have spoken before this council beginning back in May of 2023 after the death of my father in law. Bringing a petition signed by the residents of Tracy who seek safer pedestrian crossings in the City of Tracy. I also presented information regarding the DOT Safer Streets for All Grant for 2023.

But tonight the Sarmento Family and I want to Thank You the City Council, City Manager, City Staff, City Engineering Staff, Transportation Advisory Commission (Tim Silva), and the Tracy Police Department along with Chief Millington in making the Streets of Tracy Safer for All.

I have received and read the 2025 Safer Streets for All Grant application which the City of Tracy has submitted to the Federal Department of Transportation by the City Associate Engineer Selvi Sivaraj, and the endorsements from CalTrans Dist 10 Grace Magsayo, San Joaquin County Public Health Barb Alberson Sr., San Joaquin Council of Governments Diane Nguyen, City of Tracy Unified School District Donald Dias, City of Tracy Transit District Ed Lovell Transit Manager, City of Tracy Fire Authority Randall Bradley Fire Chief and City of Tracy Police Department Sekou Millington Chief of Police.

In reviewing application they have requested and identified safety improvements for ten high priority intersections and corridors in the City of Tracy. Most of them will include the Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons known as the HAWK system (high-intensity activated crosswalk beacon). This is a step up from the Rapid Flashing Beacon System that we had been seeking.

The City of Tracy and this City Council has kept its promise and its commitment to the City Council Resolution 2023-034, The Local Roadway Safety Plan and Setting a Vision Zero for 2050, by applying for and receiving the 2023, and 2024 Safer Streets for All Grants and hopefully the 2025 Grant will be awarded as well. Our family and the Citizens of Tracy are deeply appreciative for all the efforts and concerns for the safety of its citizens shown by this dedicated team of its City of Tracy employees and Council Members.
