NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The City Council of the City of Tracy will conduct a Public Hearing during its regular meeting on **Tuesday, November 18, 2025, at 7:00 p.m.**, or as soon after as possible, in the Tracy City Council Chambers, 333 Civic Center Plaza, Tracy, CA 95376 to consider and take action on:

Staff's recommendation that the Tracy City Council (1) waive the first reading by substitution of title and introduce an Ordinance amending Chapter 4.12 – Palmistry, of the Tracy Municipal Code, to add a permitting program and makes it a requirement that all persons practicing fortunetelling, palmistry or related practices for compensation in the City of Tracy obtain a permit from the Tracy Police Department, requires a criminal background investigation for all palmistry permit applicants, establishes permit and background investigation fees and specifies enforcement remedies for violations of the ordinance; (2) adopt a Resolution authorizing the Tracy Police Department to access criminal history information of palmistry permit applicants for permitting purposes; and (3) adopt a Resolution establishing fees related to palmistry permit applications and background investigations.
