

## CITY OF TRACY PUBLIC HEARING

The City of Tracy City Council will conduct a Public Hearing on **Tuesday, December 2nd, 2025, at 7:00 p.m.**, or as soon after as possible, in the Tracy City Council Chambers, 333 Civic Center Plaza, Tracy, to consider and take action on:

### **Authorization for Tracy Police Department to Enforce Traffic Laws on the Private Streets within the Redbridge Subdivision (California Vehicle Code §21107.7)**

Notice is hereby given that the Tracy City Council will conduct a public hearing on December 2nd, 2025 to consider adopting a resolution authorizing the Tracy Police Department to enforce applicable provisions of the California Vehicle Code within the private roadways of the Redbridge subdivision, pursuant to California Vehicle Code §21107.7. The Redbridge Owners' Association has formally requested this enforcement authority. If adopted, the resolution would permit the city to respond to traffic-related violations occurring on Redbridge's private streets consistent with state law and the City's municipal procedures.

#### **Notice Timing:**

This notice is being published on November 21st, 2025, which is at least 10 days prior to the public hearing, as required by California Vehicle Code §21107.7.

The City of Tracy will allow for remote participation at the upcoming City Council meeting on Tuesday, December 2nd, 2025.
