Registration Information

Resident Discount ("Res-Disc.") vs. "Cost"

Your resident address must fall within one of three Tracy Zip Codes (95376, 95377, or 95304) to receive our resident discount. In addition, your address must be within Tracy city limits. If your address has five digits or more, then your home may be outside the Tracy city limits. It is possible to live in one of the three Tracy zip codes and still not live within Tracy city limits. All non-residents pay the "cost" of a program.

Program Withdrawal/Transfer/Refund

If you are not happy with the quality of any of our programs, please contact us right away. We want to resolve your concern so you can continue, or in some instances, receive a refund. You must complete a "Request for Class/Activity Withdrawal Form" and submit to the Program Coordinator. Withdrawals are subject to a \$5 transaction fee. Refunds are subject to an additional \$5 transaction fee. If you leave a credit on your account you will not be charged the additional transaction fee. No transaction fee for classes that have been canceled.

No refunds for non-attendance due to schedule conflicts or illness, no refunds for materials fees, and no refunds for classes that have completed. Allow 5 business days to process a refund.

DO NOT ATTEND A CLASS UNTIL REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT HAVE BEEN COMPLETED. INSTRUCTORS CANNOT ACCEPT PAYMENTS.

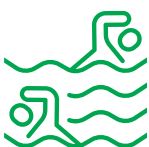

Lifeguarding Certification (15+ years)

This course includes e-learning, classroom learning, and pool time. Upon successful completion of the online course, written exams, and water skills, this course certifies participants in the American Red Cross Lifeguarding, First Aid, and CPR/AED (valid for two years). Candidates are welcome to apply for lifeguard positions with the City of Tracy after completion of the course.

Note: Prerequisite testing is completed the first day of class. All participants must pass the prerequisite tests to continue with the rest of the class. Attendance at all class days and times is required, along with passing scores on the online and written tests, and water skills in order to be certified as a Lifeguard.

PARENT TOT (6 mos- 3 years)

This class is ideal for parents and their young children who are new to the water, focusing on building comfort and foundational water skills.

- ☐ Gentle acclimation to the water alongside a parent or guardian
- ☐ Introduction to basic water movement skills through songs and play
- ☐ Learning safe water practices for both parent and child

TINY TOT (3-5 years)

This class is ideal for preschool-age children who are ready to participate more independently in the water.

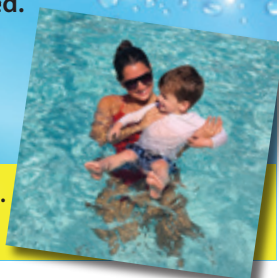

Competitive Swim Clinic (6-17 years)

Participants will learn butterfly, backstroke, breaststroke, and freestyle drills geared toward creating an efficient, fluent stroke as well as perfect their turns, streamlines, and starts. This clinic is intended for swimmers who want to develop their confidence and readiness for swim team participation.

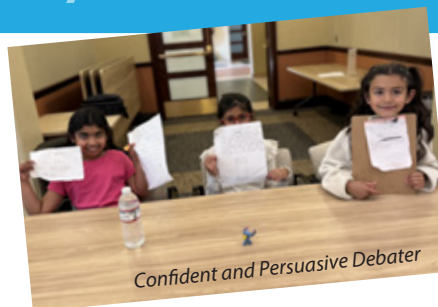
